Background Information

In 1985 BVE was formed by eighty 3rd and 4th generation grape growers who shared a passion for producing fine wine that truly reflected the character of the Barossa Valley. Crafted by the makers of the world recognised BVE E&E Black Pepper Shiraz, E Minor is a tribute to the rich cultural and musical influence of the Barossa Valley.

Tasting Notes

A deep, earthen red colour in the glass, E Minor Shiraz exudes aromas of lifted black and red fruit, subtle oak and a touch of maturity. Expect a ripe a rich mid palate with some texture, and a well rounded mouth feel, a soft tannin backbone with a smooth, soft finish.

Winemaker's Notes

The fruit for this wine was grown in a cool long ripening period, harvested by hand and machine, aged in 50% French, 50% American for 6 months and developed using gentle processing techniques to retain fruit integrity
