Background Information

In 1985 BVE was formed by eighty 3rd and 4th generation grape growers who shared a passion for producing fine wine that truly reflected the character of the Barossa Valley. Crafted by the makers of the world recognised BVE E&E Black Pepper Shiraz, E Minor is a tribute to the rich cultural and musical influence of the Barossa Valley.

Tasting Notes

Pale straw in colour with green hues, the Barossa Valley Estate E Minor Chardonnay reveals lifted aromas of rip citrus with very faint background oak. This chardonnay has a firm fruit driven palate with a touch of creaminess, finished crisply with citrus and apricot notes.

Winemaker's Notes

A Great growing season - warm summer and mild autumn. The wine was produced with minimal handling under inert conditions with cool fermentation to preserve freshness of fruit character and purity. A light oak influence has enhanced the complexity and balance the fruit backbone of this fine wine.
