### | Wine |

Deep red in colour with purple hues, this wine exhibits rich Shiraz aromas of black cherries, plums, spices and notes of savoury pepper along with some beautifully integrated oak sweetness and spice.

### | Winemaker's Comments |

The 2007 vintage was one of the toughest on record with drought conditions throughout the growing season. These conditions saw a decrease in yields with small intensely flavoured berries the norm contributing to one of the smallest vintages for BVE in many years. Fortunately the quality was exceptional with the BVE vineyard at Marananga contributing close to 50% of the E Minor blend with five growers vineyards making up the rest.
